Dear Audience.

The combination of high-quality music and socialising (dare I say partying?) is unrivalled at Hindsgavl Festival. After a dreadful Corona-period both performers and audience are more than ready for this cocktail, and we are therefore in for an unforgettable festival this year!

While we are still waiting for clear political signals re. Corona-restrictions for the summer, the festival planning is proceeding almost as normal.

Naturally, we have responsible and detailed contingency plans in place ensuring that the festival - even with some restrictions - may take place.

In advance, we have canceled the festival's small series of contemporary / avantgarde music to avoid too many concerts per day, and to avoid using the castle's smaller halls.

IN CASE OF CANCELLATION ..

If the festival is canceled, ticket holders will be offered a full refund.

If the corona situation in any way prevents tickets holders from participating in the festival (due to travel restrictions, quarantine rules, etc.), the general cancellation conditions in the trading conditions apply. Therefore: If you are unsure of the situation, you may opt for an individual cancellation insurance. This is not offered nor mediated by the festival.

The series has not previously been published in the present program, and it will therefore not be perceived as a change in case you already purchased your tickets.

Anyway, most of the program for 2021 was determined long time ago, when the World was still relatively sane.

So enough about restrictions and let us instead look forward to a long list of wonderful musicians and singers in July 2021: Christian Gerhaher, Isabelle Faust, András Schiff, Jean-Guihen Queyras, Pavel Haas Quartet, Martin Helmchen, Carolin Widmann, and many, many others. Where else can one find so many extraordinary musicians and singers gathered in one place in the space of a week?

In 2021 we welcome the largest share of foreign guests ever, especially from Germany. We are honored that so many of you will travel to our festival and look forward to including you in our musical circle which we like to maintain very relaxed and hearty.

The figures of the Amazons were a great source of inspiration for 18th century composers. In these works, we find recurring female characters: queens (Antiope, Mitilene, Hippolyte, Talestri, Marthésie) or androgynous beings, either female or warriors.

The Amazons theme will be featured in a Franco-Italian Baroque program with rising star soprano Lea Desandre and Ensemble Jupiter. Much of the music hasn't been performed since it was written centuries ago.

Tickets with accommodation in the castle

Accommodation is in the 120-room castle (manor house) itself where everything is within walking distance: Concerts, meals, etc.

Per person in Double Room* **EUR 180,- / day**

Single Room **EUR 270 /day**

Single Room (HUSET)** **EUR 200,- /day**

For 18 and 22 July: A surcharge of 12% is added. Furthermore,

* **Upgrades:** When ordering you may ask for newly renovated rooms in the stables. The castle will charge you an extra EUR 27/day for this which is to be paid to

the reception at check-out. A Junior Suite will cost an extra 54 EUR/day.

** Single rooms are also sold in the nearby hotel facility HUSET, a 1 km walk/drive through the Hindsgavl Deer Park to the castle. Morning buffet is in the castle. Address is Hindsgavl Allé 2 – 5500 Middelfart and website: www.huset-middelfart.dk/

What is included?

The festival stay starts with room check-in from 14:00 on the date of arrival and ends on departure day with check-out at 10:00 or before.

The 18th century Hindsgavl Castle is located 3 km from the picturesque city of Middelfart and only 200 meters from the sea. Once you have reached the castle, everything is in walking distance: Rooms, concert venues, dining, rooms, etc.

Distances by car/bicycle

German border: 100 km; Copenhagen: 215 km;
Hamburg: 265 km; Berlin: 540 km; Paris: 1.150 km.

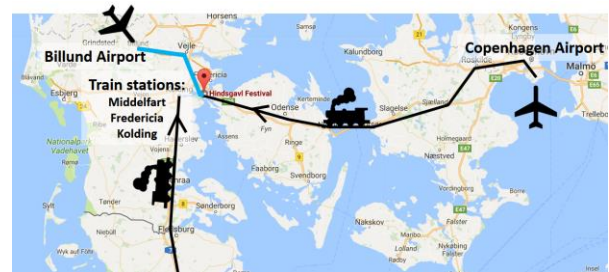
By train from Germany

Good connections from Germany. You should aim for Middelfart Station (via Kolding or Fredericia). From there, a five minute drive (taxi: 10-12 Euro) takes you to Hindsgavl. Travel time from Hamburg is about 3 hours 30 minutes.

By airplane

Closest airport is **Billund Airport**, 65 km from Hindsgavl. Taxi costs around 125 Euro, one-way. Bus/train is possible but complicated.

Alternative airport is **Copenhagen Airport (Kastrup)**: There are direct train connections between this airport and the town of Middelfart. These trains depart on an hourly basis with a commuting time of approx. 2h 20 min.
